CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

CLIMBING - Erik Glass

Children will learn the basics of climbing safety, rope work, knots, belaying, rappelling, equipment & proper climbing techniques (beginners to intermediates) on the rock climbing wall in the gym.

The basic idea is to use GPS coordinates to locate hidden containers (geocaches) and then share your experiences online. This outdoor sport is a combination of orienteering, hiking, secret identities, technology and good old detective work. Geocaching is enjoyed by people of all age groups, and builds a strong sense of community and support for the environment. Come find out why this sport is gaining popularity worldwide!

GOLF - Fran Hoxie

Children will get help to improve their golf game. Those new to golf will start from the beginning and learn the basics. Students will need their own clubs and a ride to and from the course
